

All visits to Owensboro Parks & Recreation Website are automatically recorded in a log file maintained on our web server. The information we collect is anonymous: namely, it is general information such as what pages are viewed, what types of software you use to access the site, and what site, if any, linked you to the Owensboro Parks & Recreation website. Other information is collected on a voluntary basis when users send or input information into the site. This information is used only to provide or improve city services and is not shared with other organizations for commercial purposes. Personal data in our possession is maintained and used in ways that respect individual privacy and will never be shared or sold to other entities, with the exception of health information collected and shared in the case of providing medical treatment.

- 1. Only skateboards, inline skates and BMX bikes are allowed.
- 2. This is an unsupervised park and all users do so strictly at his/her own risk. The City of Owensboro does not assume any responsibility for loss or injury.
- 3. Use of this park is permitted during posted hours only. Violators may be cited or fined.
- 4. Use of safety equipment such as helmets & pads is strongly recommended.
- 5. All those under 18 years of age shall have adult supervision.
- 6. Bicycles must have protective covering on all pegs.
- 7. Weather conditions such as rain, snow and ice can impair ramps & skating surfaces. The Skate Park should not be used in those weather conditions.
- 8. Be aware of your surroundings at all times while using the Skate Park. Loose and/or flying skateboards are possible.
- 9. Spectators shall stay off the concrete.
- 10. Obstacles, ramps or other equipment that are not a part of the original structure are not permitted to be used or added to the facility.
- 11. Improper conduct may result in suspension or expulsion from the park & may result in temporary closure of the facility.
- 12. Special events require permitting by the City of Owensboro.
- 13. Please skate safely & be respectful & courteous to others. Share the park.
- 14. The following are not permitted in the park:

 - ♦ Drugs
 - ♦ Profanity


Rudy Mine Trails at Ben Hawes Park

Enjoy a little bit of the country on the double track hiking trail through the park. The trails are comprised of a series of three loops – three trails that interconnect equaling 4 miles – easy to moderate rating. The single track trails were designed by mountain bikers. With 8.25 miles of scenic trails and amazing terrain, these trails offer something for every level rider or outdoor enthusiast!

The trail entrance is located at mile marker 8 on Hwy 60 West.



Located near the intersection of the Wendell Ford Expressway and Hwy 60 West, behind the Green River Area Development District (GRADD) Office. Named in honor of Joe Ford who developed the 15 acre woodland into an outdoor classroom. The park also serves as a trailhead for the Adkisson Greenbelt Park – West Owensboro Trail and has a Nature Center.

It operates Tuesday – Thursday 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Friday 9:00 a.m. – Noon. Walking trails, with 10 Station fitness equipment, is open for your enjoyment 365 days a year during daylight hours.






Paved Walking Trails

Adkisson Greenbelt Park

The Greenbelt Park is designed to encircle the city, linking neighborhoods, business districts, parks and schools. The trails that make up the Greenbelt Park offer a 10-foot wide asphalt surface that will easily accommodate pedestrians and bicyclists and meets the Americans with Disabilities Act Standards. Whether you enjoy walking, running, skating or bicycling for recreation, fitness, or to reach a destination, the Adkisson Greenbelt Park is an enjoyable and healthy place to be.
